CIB W-78 Computer-Aided Design 14 August 83; 1400-1700 Folkets Plus Stockholm, Sweden Meeting Notes

- 1. Participants are listed in enclosure 1. Participants at the W-78 Meeting opened the meeting by describing their interests and goals in W-78.
- a. I, Ms. Spoonamore, started by saying that my goal is to promote integrated CAD research and development and to immediately catalog the current CAD systems and the ongoing research and development of integrated CAD projects.
- b. Dr. Wright expressed that he is the W-78 counselor to help the working group get started.
- c. Dr. Christiansson expressed that he is part-time research at Lund Institute and part-time consultant to the Swedish Building Research Council. He is interested in integrated CAD.
- d. Mr. Karlsson expressed that his organization provides information and education to the A/E's. He is interested in IGES for transfer of data among design disciplines.
- e. Mr. Koselkov, representing his organization in USSR, presented the paper in enclosure 2.
 - f. Mr. Volbeda expressed that he wants to promote the usage of CAD.
- g. Mr. Orshan, on a Fulbright scholarship to Tampere University, Finland, wants to research life-cycle costs throughout the building life-cycle and the possible implementation of CAD at Tampere.
- h. Mr. Wilson expressed that he is representing Mr. Dana Vanier at the W-78 meeting.
- i. Mr. Roesch expressed he is active in W-65 and will be at Waterloo. His organization has been involved in an automated specifications systems, scheduling and working plans.
- j. Dr. Haas expressed that his organization has been involved in development of computer software for 20 years and are now developing 3-D models.
- k. Mr. Agger expressed that the Arhus School of Architecture will learn CAD from the ABACUS system and evaluate three CAD systems at three architectural offices and that he hopes to develop their own system.
- 1. Mr. Larsen wants to learn the impacts of CAD on the current design process.
